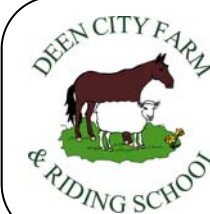

## About our Riding School

We are a small, friendly Riding Establishment with around 12 ponies and horses, ranging from 11hh to 17hh.

Whether training for exams, competing or if you just want to have a go our staff and horses can cater for anyone aged 8 or older.

## Weather Conditions

Tuition, hacks and other activities carry on weather permitting. If weather conditions are too adverse, stable management lessons may be offered instead. If in doubt, ring to check because full payment is required for bookings made unless at least 48 hours of cancellation for weekend rides & 24 hours during the week

## What to Wear



Comfortable trousers; riding boots, jodphur boots or a walking or school shoe with a smooth sole & a heel no greater than one inch. Trainers & bulky welly boots are not suitable; jewellery should not be worn & long hair should be tied back; gloves; short coat for the winter; shoulders should always be covered; riding hats to the current BS standards are provided.

## Cancellation Policy

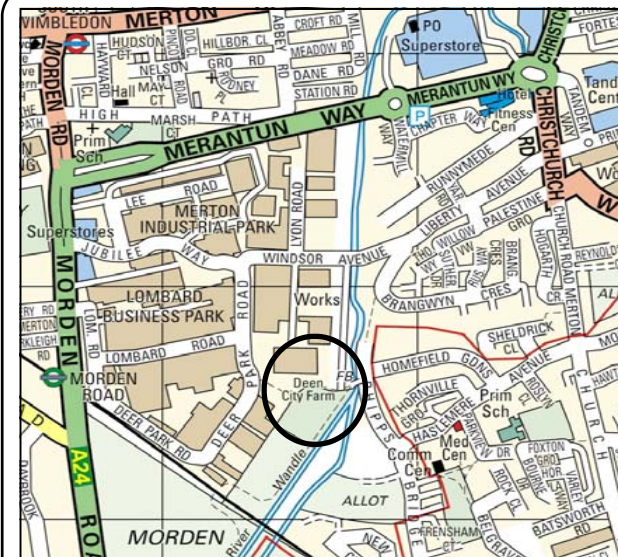
**24 hours notice for a week day**

- Riding is a **Risk Sport**



## How To Get to Deen City Farm

Information is available in detail in the leaflet "How to get to Deen City Farm" which can be downloaded from our website or sent to you by post or email.



Colliers Wood and South Wimbledon on the Northern Line are within walking distance. It will take you about 20 minutes from either tube station.



Use either the 93 or 200 bus which join Wimbledon to Putney and Mitcham respectively. The 200 bus takes you to within a few minutes walk of the Farm. The 93 bus leaves a 10 minute walk to the Farm.



Use Morden Road or Phipps Bridge stops. It's a 10 minute walk from either.



There is access to Windsor Avenue from either Liberty Avenue or Jubilee Way. We have a visitors car park which is accessible during opening hours.

## Your Lesson

It is advisable to arrive at least 10 minutes before your ride time in order to pay and check any bookings. We do our best to be punctual and so anyone arriving late for a lesson will only be admitted at the discretion of the instructor. The safety of our riders is of paramount importance and whilst every possible precaution is taken, we must remind you that all riders ride at their own risk and it is advisable to take out your own personal accident insurance.
